Implementation Regulations for Academic Scholarships in the Department of Applied Chinese at Kainan University

I. Merit Scholarship Regulations for Students Enrolling from the Second Semester of the 106-2 Academic Year Onward:

Starting from the second semester of the 106-2 academic year for students enrolling in or after that semester, a merit scholarship will be provided each semester.

Quota: 10% of the number of students for that academic year (rounded up unconditionally)

Amount: The top student will be awarded NT\$20,000, and the remaining students will be awarded NT\$6,000 each.

(1) Eligibility:

Pass all subjects with a grade of at least 80; conduct grades above 80; meet the minimum credit requirements; have no outstanding records of tuition or health insurance fees.

Students applying for merit scholarships in the second semester (third term), third semester (fourth term), and fourth semester (fifth term) must pass the B1 level of the Chinese Proficiency Test (華測進階級). Applicants for the fifth semester (sixth term) and sixth semester (seventh term) merit scholarships must pass the B2 level of the Chinese Proficiency Test (華測高階級).

Those who lose eligibility due to transfer, suspension, or repeated receipt of other scholarships within the university will not be replenished.

(2) Review Criteria:

The list of eligible students and their academic performance will be reviewed by the departmental meeting. Students whose class ranking is within the proportion specified in the scholarship regulations of the International Office are eligible for the award. After confirming the list of awardees, it will be submitted to the International and Cross-Strait Affairs Office.

These regulations shall come into effect after being approved by the departmental meeting and shall apply to amendments as well.
