Notes

1. Students must complete in total of 30 credits for graduation, of which 10 credits from required courses, 20 credits from core optional courses.
2. Students have to pass the Master's thesis examination (0 credits).
3. Those who are eligible to apply for an oral defense must complete 24 credits of the total required ones.
4. Students enrolled in this unit are required to complete teaching practicum at language centers that are registered or recognized by national or international education authorities or professional evaluation groups at all levels of schools or institutions. They teach non-native speakers of Chinese for at least 72 hours.
5. International students are not required to hold any language proficiency test certificates, whereas international students need to pass the TOCFL fluency (C1) level listening, reading or speaking or writing test to graduate.
6. Students must submit at least one full paper to a national or international academic conference or journal before graduation. For those who are unable to fulfill the requirement before their oral defenses taking place, their advisers of MA dissertations have to provide letters to state the details of the paper publications.
7. Academic Ethics are required courses for 0 credits. In accordance with Regulations of KNU Academic Ethics Courses, students could apply for academic degree oral defense after passing the academic ethics courses.
8. These courses regulations were passed at the Curriculum Committee Meeting on May 18th. 2021, and approved for future references by Academics Affairs Meeting on May 18th, 2021.
